## Report about the 368<sup>th</sup> Study Circle Meeting of IASLIC

The 368th Study Circle Meeting of IASLIC was held on 27th November, 2025 (Thursday) at 3:00 pm at the Central Library of the University of Kalyani, Nadia, West Bengal. The speaker of the above-mentioned Study Circle Meeting was Dr. Swati Ghosh, Librarian, Savitri Girls College, Kolkata. The Chairperson of the meeting was Prof (Dr) Partha Sarathi Mukhopadhyay, Department of Library and Information Science, University of Kalyani, Nadia, W.B. The Co-Chairperson of the abovementioned study circle meeting was Dr. Dipa Roy, Librarian (In-charge), University of Kalyani, Nadia, W.B. The Topic of the discussion at the said study circle meeting of IASLIC was "Information, Communication on Health Awareness: Role of Street Libraries in Kolkata". Welcoming the dignitaries, guests and audience, Mr Abhijit Kumar, General Secretary of IASLIC, briefly stated the activities of IASLIC and history of the study circle meetings. Thereafter Dr Tridib Chattopadhyay, Convenor, Study Circle Division, IASLIC, introduced the Speaker and the Chairperson of the session. Prof. (Dr.) Partha Sarathi Mukhopadhyay gave an overview of the issues regarding the availability of health information and the possible ways of accessing the health information. After that the speaker Dr. Swati Ghosh started the session and delivered her lecture on the particular issue.

In this lecture Dr. Swati Ghosh discussed the nature and extent of the street libraries and the conceptual development of the street libraries in and around Kolkata city. Health literacy is an important aspect to every individual in the society, as a health literate person understands his / her health status, can take preventive and curative measures of various diseases. But In reality, many people lack health literacy and many research reports are showing that 88% of the population have insufficient health literacy levels and are limiting their ability to effectively navigate the healthcare system and support their well-being. Street libraries those are evolved into important information centres can act as health information dissemination centres Dr Ghosh added. Many nations have adopted national plans to improve health literacy. Also individuals are required to access the free flow of huge and effective health information in a proper manner and the role of librarians and information professionals are important to disseminate the information and distribute it through proper channels of communication. In this respect, this discussion focuses on the importance of the street library especially in a developing nation like India. The lecture was followed by a question - answer session. The Chairperson of the session Prof. (Dr.) Partha Sarathi Mukhopadhyay summarized entire discussion in a pinpointed manner. The students, teachers and research scholars took active part in the discussion. The Chairperson also stated that he has gained a lot of knowledge from this valuable and thought provoking lecture by Dr. Ghosh. Overall this lecture was appreciated by the audience. Dr Dipa Roy, Dr. Debebrata Bhattacharyya, Mr. Abhijit Kumar, Mr. Sukalyan Majumder, Mr. Rajib and a few students & scholars took active part in the discussion. The vote of thanks was delivered by Mr. Sukalyan Majumder of the Central Library of the University of Kalyani, Nadia, West Bengal. After that, Dr Tridib Chattopadhyay, Convenor of the Study Circle Division of IASLIC thanked all the dignitaries, guests and the audience regarding their active participation and involvement. ## Author Guidelines for Paper Submission

- 1. Contributed papers must be of substantial scholarly value to qualify for publication in the IASLIC Special Publication (ISSN 0972-3668), Volume 62 a peer-reviewed post-conference volume. Authors are advised to avoid generalized or superficial presentations.
- 2. Full research papers should not exceed 2,500 words (a maximum of 10 pages, A4 size) and must be accompanied by an informative abstract of 300–400 words. Submissions should be typed on one side of the page, double-spaced, in Times New Roman 12-point font, with 1.5-inch margins on all sides. Two hard copies of the paper must reach the organisers on or before October 31, 2025.
- 3. An Author's Declaration in the prescribed format must be signed by all authors in sequence and submitted along with the paper, clearly indicating the sub-theme and topic of the contribution.
- 4. Authors must also submit a separate signed declaration in hard copy stating that the paper has not been submitted elsewhere for publication or presentation.
- 5.A soft copy of the full paper (in MS Word format, .doc/.docx) should also be submitted as an attachment via email to iaslic.sem@gmail.com
- 6. For references and citations, contributors must adhere strictly to the IASLIC Authorship Manual: Standard and Specification available at :IASLIC Authorship Manual
- 7. Each paper must be accompanied by a non-refundable submission fee of Rs.1200/- (Rupees One Thousand Two Hundred only). - 1. Once a paper has been submitted, no changes in authorship will be permitted.
- The Pre-Conference Abstract Volume will include only the informative abstracts of accepted papers.
- 3. All accepted papers will be scheduled for presentation either in the main thematic sessions of the Conference or in the SIG Meetings. Each presenter will be allotted a maximum of 15 minutes, including introduction and conclusion.
- 4. There will be a provision for Poster Presentations. Authors of accepted poster papers will be given time to display their full papers. The abstracts of all poster presentations will be included in the Pre-Conference Abstract Volume.
- 5.A Best Poster Presentation Award will be instituted. The award-winning paper is likely to be included in the Post-Conference Volume. Other poster papers will not be considered for post-conference publication.






