Report about the 369th Study Circle Meeting of IASLIC

The 369th Study Circle Meeting of IASLIC was held on 11th December, 2025 (Thursday) at 6:00 pm at the meeting room of IASLIC which is situated at P-291, CIT Scheme 6M, Kankurgachhi, Kolkata - 700054. The speaker of the above-mentioned Study Circle Meeting was Dr. Animesh Bhattacharyya, Librarian, Vivekananda Mahavidyalaya, Haripal, Hooghly, West Bengal. The Chairman of the meeting was Dr. Nitai Raychowdhury, Librarian, City College, Kolkata. The Topic of the discussion at the said study circle meeting of IASLIC was "*Senior Citizens and Community Engagement in Public Libraries*". At the beginning, Mr. Abhijit Kumar, General Secretary of IASLIC, welcomed all the dignitaries, guests and audience. He has briefly stated about the history of the study circle meetings of IASLIC. Thereafter Dr. Tridib Chattopadhyay, Convenor, Study Circle Division, IASLIC, introduced the Speaker and the Chairman of the session. Dr. Nitai Raychowdhury, the Chairman of the said meeting has given an overview of the issues regarding the problems of the senior citizens and the probable role of the librarians as well as the libraries. After that, the speaker Dr. Animesh Bhattacharyya started the session and delivered his lecture on the particular topic of discussion. In this lecture, Dr. Animesh Bhattacharyya has discussed the nature and extent of the problems faced by the senior citizens and the services provided by the public libraries of different countries throughout the world. Dr. Bhattacharyya has discussed about the conceptual development of the special sections of public libraries for the senior citizens in our country. Dr. Bhattacharyya has stated that the public libraries can act as the mental health counselling centres for the senior citizens, and the public libraries can also act as the health information dissemination centres for the senior citizens of our country. As such, individual senior citizens are required to access the free flow of huge and effective physical health information as well as mental health information in a proper manner and the role of librarians and information professionals are important to disseminate the information and distribute it through proper channels of communication. In this respect, this discussion focuses on the importance of the public library especially in a developing nation like India. The lecture was followed by a question - answer session. Prof. Krishna Pada Majumder, Mr. Jagamohan Das, Mr. Pradip Sarkar, Miss Moumita Ash and other senior members of IASLIC have taken part in the discussion. After that, the Chairman of the session Dr. Nitai Raychowdhury has briefly described the entire discussion in a pinpointed manner. The students, teachers and research scholars have taken active part in the discussion. The Chairman and other dignitaries have stated that they have gained a lot of knowledge from

this valuable and thought provoking lecture by Dr. Animesh Bhattacharyya. It was a fruitful discussion. Overall this lecture was appreciated by all the audience. Author Guidelines for Paper Submission

1. Contributed papers must be of substantial scholarly value to qualify for publication in the IASLIC Special Publication (ISSN 0972-3668), Volume 62 — a peer-reviewed post-conference volume. Authors are advised to avoid generalized or superficial presentations.
 2. Full research papers should not exceed 2,500 words (a maximum of 10 pages, A4 size) and must be accompanied by an informative abstract of 300-400 words. Submissions should be typed on one side of the page, double-spaced, in Times New Roman 12-point font, with 1.5-inch margins on all sides. Two hard copies of the paper must reach the organisers on or before October 31, 2025.
 3. An Author's Declaration in the prescribed format must be signed by all authors in sequence and submitted along with the paper, clearly indicating the sub-theme and topic of the contribution.
 4. Authors must also submit a separate signed declaration in hard copy stating that the paper has not been submitted elsewhere for publication or presentation.
 5. A soft copy of the full paper (in MS Word format, .doc/.docx) should also be submitted as an attachment via email to iaslic.sem@gmail.com
 6. For references and citations, contributors must adhere strictly to the IASLIC Authorship Manual: Standard and Specification available at :IASLIC Authorship Manual
 7. Each paper must be accompanied by a non-refundable submission fee of Rs.1200/- (Rupees One Thousand Two Hundred only). Additional Guidelines

1. Once a paper has been submitted, no changes in authorship will be permitted.
2. The Pre-Conference Abstract Volume will include only the informative abstracts of accepted papers.
3. All accepted papers will be scheduled for presentation either in the main thematic sessions of the Conference or in the SIG Meetings. Each presenter will be allotted a maximum of 15 minutes, including introduction and conclusion.
4. There will be a provision for Poster Presentations. Authors of accepted poster papers will be given time to display their full papers. The abstracts of all poster presentations will be included in the Pre-Conference Abstract Volume.
5. A Best Poster Presentation Award will be instituted. The award-winning paper is likely to be included in the Post-Conference Volume. Other poster papers will not be considered for post-conference publication.
6. Only those papers that are accepted and presented at the Conference will be considered for publication in the peer-reviewed IASLIC Special Publication (ISSN 0972-3668), Volume 62, subject to merit. The Post-Conference Volume is expected to be published within three months of the Conference.
7. All registered participants will receive a complimentary copy of the IASLIC Special Publication (ISSN 0972-3668), Volume 62, from the IASLIC office.
8. For those wishing to purchase the volume by post, an additional charge of Rs. 150/- will be levied towards packaging and postage, over and above the cost price.
9. The decision of the Editorial Committee regarding the acceptance of papers for presentation or publication shall be final and binding. No correspondence in this matter will be entertained.

How to Reach Vijayapura?

By Air:

The nearest domestic airports are at Kalaburagi, Hubballi, and Belagavi, each located approximately 200 km from Vijayapura. Taxi services are available at all these airports for onward travel. The city is also accessible via Solapur (100 km), Pune (380 km), and Hyderabad (500 km) airports.

By Train:

Vijayapura Railway Station lies on the South Central Western line between Hubballi and Solapur. It has direct train connectivity from Bengaluru, Mumbai and Hyderabad. The nearest major railhead, however, is Solapur Junction (100 km away), which is well connected to all parts of the country. From Solapur, Vijayapura can be reached conveniently by bus or train.

By Road:

Vijayapura is well connected by road and can be reached easily via state and interstate transport services, including KSRTC, APSRTC, TSRTC, MSRTC, KTCL, as well as a wide network of private buses.






